Then Eli realized—God was calling Samuel! He told Samuel, "Next time, say, 'Speak, Lord, I am listening."


Samuel did, and God spoke to him!

Prayer: Lord help me to always remember that I am special to you



Instead of being angry, his father ran to hug him and welcomed him back with love! Just like the father forgave his son, God forgives us when we ask Him!
